Stanwood Middle School students will exceed the state average on the English Language Arts assessment and the Mathematics portions of the Smarter Balanced Assessment by 2%. We are focusing our instruction around best teaching practices by utilizing the 5 Dimensions of Teaching and Learning as we make the shift to the Washington State Learning Standards.

For the 2016-2017 school year, our achievement goals are based on the Washington State Assessment Average. In spring of 2017, Stanwood Middle School will exceed the state average in both Mathematics and English Language Arts as tested with the Smarter Balanced Assessment.

Through the school improvement plan process, Stanwood Middle School has identified a focus and will increase student achievement in all areas. By having consistent strategies and interventions in all contents areas, we will maintain consistent student growth over time.
