Attached are the schedules for lunch prices and for fees proposed by the school principals for fiscal year 2017-18. There are no changes being proposed to breakfast and lunch prices. There is a proposed decrease of milk price from 60 cents to 50 cents. Don Vennetti, Food Services Director, feels the lower price point will increase milk sales.

Stanwood High School increased the fee for the “Glass” class to \$45 due to anticipated glass cost increases. Stanwood Middle added a fee for the Family and Consumer Science class added in 2016-17. To offset costs, there is a proposed fee of \$10 for sixth grade and \$20 for seventh and eighth grades.

Board Policy 3520 requires an annual fee report be submitted to the board for the coming year. The policy does not require board approval of student fees, just a report.

Recommendation:

We recommend the board *move to accept the student fee schedule and food service price schedule report as attached for FY 2017-18.*
