Prior to a student enrolling at the skills center, it will be determined that the placement is in the best interest of the student without fiscally impacting the Stanwood-Camano School District. I have been assured that whether or not any student attends the skills center, there will be neither a participation fee nor other fees assessed to our school district.

This Agreement is hereby entered into by and between the Northwest Career & Technical Academy, Mount Vernon School District No. 320, Skagit County, Washington, which is hereinafter referred to as the "Serving District," and

Stanwood Camano School District No. 401, Snohomish County, Washington, hereinafter referred to as the "Participating District".

The purpose of this Agreement is to utilize interdistrict cooperation, authorized by RCW 28A.355.160, RCW 28A.225.250, and Chapter 392-135 WAC, to provide educational programs not otherwise available and to avoid duplications of specialized programs and facilities.
