Facebook threat update

Hello SCSD Families,

As you are aware, we received a message through our district Facebook account that made a threat to our schools. The police were notified, and we worked alongside them in the morning hours to determine if the message presented a credible threat to our students or staff. It was determined that this was not the case.

A similar message was also sent to other districts in the region. Law enforcement is investigating the incident as a hoax and will take legal action on its end. We are in regular contact with and have developed this message in partnership with the Snohomish County Sheriff's Department, including Deputy Bud McCurry.

All of our schools ran regular schedules today with no incident. Additional staff and safety personnel were circulating at all of our campuses today.

Our highest priority is the safety of your children, our staff and our community. We will not hesitate to close schools should that ever be necessary, now or in the future.
