# Transportation Department

- Our buses traveled over 530,000 miles last year, still down from pre-Covid miles of over 800,000.
- Our department transports over 3,000 students per day
- We have 63 buses in our fleet. Forty Type D 78 passenger transit buses, 20 type A special need buses and three conventionals.
- There are 24 regular routes, 12 special need routes and 9 McKinney Vento routes, so far this year.

### Bus Purchases

- Three new 78 passenger transit buses will be delivered in December and January to keep up with the depreciation schedule. Two new special need buses will be delivered in the spring.

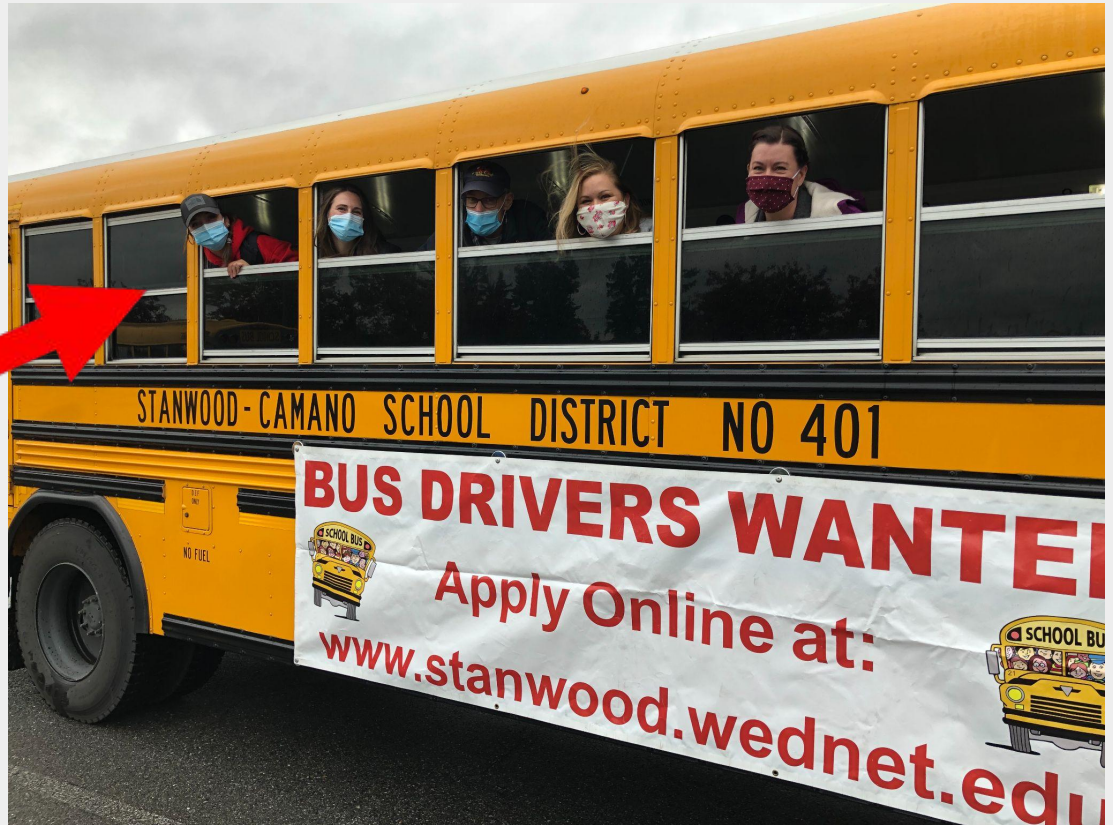
### Be Prepared
